

Buckhannon Stockyards and Weston Livestock Market will conduct yearling board sales next week. You will want to mark your calendars for these sales. The Buckhannon Stockyards sale on (Tuesday- Aug 24, 9:00 am) and Weston Livestock Mkt.(Thursday-Aug 26 at 9:00 am.) Should you have questions about any of the lots give one of us a call and we will be glad to answer any questions you have about the cattle. Please give the auction market or Phil a call for a number if you plan to participate on the telephone.

**Note the comments and pickups** on the cattle and be sure they coincide with your needs. If cattle are held longer than 14 days or the date declared, the final average weight will be adjusted a pound per day. The cattle will be sold with a slide to be announced closer to sale day. Some lots vary for weigh conditions so you may want to mark your sheets and/or pay close attention on sale day. Some of the smaller lots may be sold with choice and privilege to make loads. A 48 hour notice of delivery must be given to the owner of the cattle. Payment and loading arrangements will be conducted by the sponsoring stockyard.

**Note:** Both Sale sheets be faxed or emailed try avoid mixing them up. The sale sheets are posted on the [http://www.wvbeef.org/sales/20090804-6\\_board.pdf](http://www.wvbeef.org/sales/20090804-6_board.pdf) website if you need another copy. We are going to utilize a fax service to distribute sale sheets. That may mean if your fax machine does not remain ready to receive your may not receive the sheets.
