

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The *Eastern Panhandle Quality Assurance Board Sale* will be held on **October 14, 2011** beginning at **1:00 p.m.** in Franklin at the Community Building. **PLEASE CALL: [304.358.2286](tel:304.358.2286)** for phone hook-up and bidder numbers before sale.

The Quality Assurance sale features some of the highest quality calves available anywhere. The WV Gold Health program was followed by the producers participating in the pool. All of the lots in this sale will feature certified WVBQA feeder calves.

**Pools can provide USDA (PVP) certificates to verify the source and birth dates on the calves. All the cattle will have EID and Unique Visual ear tags.**

Most of the calves will be weighed individually to improve uniformity but most importantly to collect performance data. Please do not remove the eartags from these calves. All calves can be traced back to the producer. If you purchase calves you will be receiving a packet explaining the health products used and a list of all calves purchased. We are trying to recover as much data as possible. If you will share – we can continue to improve the quality of the calves.

All calves are home raised farm fresh and weaned 45 days. Producers have been using proven genetics and calves from previous years have performed well in the feedlot and on the rail.
